Important Dates:

- July 28: Summer Reading Program Party @ 2:00 PM. Grand prize drawings for those who complete their reading logs. Winners who are present will get first choice of prizes.

Registration:

Youth from ages 0-18 may register, and they do not have to be present to register.

Programs:

- The Zoo to You program is tentatively scheduled and is subject to cancellation. Confirmation of this event will occur in early May.
- Attendance at all programs may be limited by fire code or other safety reasons, and by supply limitations.
- The Salvage Art Clubs (crafts) are limited to 35 participants.
- The Magic Workshop is limited to 25 participants.
- The Wonders on Wheels is limited to 15 at a time inside the Dino Trailer.
- For the Salvage Art Club, Magic Workshop, and Zoo to You admission tickets will be given out 30 minutes prior to the start of the program.
- Programs are designed for specific age groups. If an age specific program must be limited due to high attendance, age will be a determining factor.
 - All Ages: Wonders on Wheels, the Magic Guy, the Yo-Yo Master, Curious Chris, Zoo to You & Rocky Mountain Puppets
 - Ages 0-5: Babytime, Children's Movies, Storytime
 - Ages 6-12: Magic Workshop, Future Engineers, Salvage Art Club, Breakout Game
 - Ages 10+: Teen Movies, Wildworks, Teen Hangout
