

Patron in good standing

The term “new card” means a card that is in its probationary period. A new library member’s card will be considered in its probationary period for 6 weeks after it is issued. After six weeks, the probationary period is over.

A library patron cannot use a new card to borrow interlibrary loan items, internet hotspots, or other electronic devices. There is a limit of five items on a new card.

A library user is considered a “patron in good standing” if they meet the following requirements:

- Their card is not a new card
- Their card is not expired
- They have no charges on their card
- They have no nonrenewable overdue items on their card

Library staff reserve the right to revoke a patron’s “good standing” status if the patron violates library policies. Examples include, but are not limited to, repeatedly returning technology equipment late or damaging library equipment.
