

Robert and Wilma Knox Collection



The Robert and Wilma Knox Collection consist of various materials on First Lieutenant Charles Gatewood including materials on Geronimo and the conflict between Native Americans and the United States in the late nineteenth century.

The donated items consist of approximately 100 books, 20 newspaper and magazine articles, 8 microfilm reels from the Arizona Historical Society's Charles Gatewood files, and two images.

The material covers Gatewood life and his service in the military, Gatewood's parents and their life in Woodstock, Virginia and material about Gatewood's wife and children. The donation also includes materials on the U.S. Military Academy, biographies on numerous military figures in the nineteenth century American West, the history of the U.S. Calvary, and the American Indian Wars.
